RIVER LAKE DAYS BUTTON - The River Lake Days logo, originally designed by Bernie Doll and modified by Jenny Evens, has been transferred onto a button, a very important part of River Lake Days. The button, which costs \$3.00, helps defray the cost of all entertainment, including the fireworks, and can be purchased at area businesses prior to River Lake Days. Admission to all events and shows during River Lake Days is free for anyone wearing a button. There will be a cover charge at certain times for those not wearing a button, with the exception of children 5 and under, who are free. There are also nightly button number drawings totaling \$800 in cash prizes. You need not be present to win and winning numbers will be posted at local businesses and published in the *Cold Spring Record*. Buttons and T-shirts can also be purchased at the Mini-Donut Stand starting at 12:00 noon on Saturday, July 19th.
